Sageder's art delves into the complexities of human nature and its connection to the evolutionary narrative. By drawing on mystical and ritualistic themes, she constructs a dialogue that transcends time and space, exploring the essence of existence and transformation. Her sculptures and reliefs often incorporate organic forms and textures, creating a tactile and immersive experience for the viewer.

The use of impasto in her oil paintings adds a dimensional quality, inviting viewers to engage with the physicality of the medium. Through her art, Sageder challenges perceptions and encourages contemplation on the fluid boundaries between human and animal, past and future, reality and imagination. Her work resonates on a universal level, offering a poetic reflection on the interconnectedness of life and the ongoing evolution of the human spirit.

Iris Sageder has presented her work in a range of national and international exhibitions. Her works have been showcased at Albertina Modern Vienna, art:badgastein, spark Vienna, Gallery Lisa Kandlhofer, Novomatic Art Forum, Kunstraum Nestroyhof in Vienna, LHM Moscow, and Stiftung Zukunft Berlin.
